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Drums have evolved slowly throughout the ages and one change that can clearly be seen is the different method of tensioning the skins between medieval and Renaissance drums. The medieval drum is rope tensioned directly onto thick goat skin heads and has a single snare on the beaten head, whilst the Renaissance drum applies the rope tensioning through counter hoops which spread the forces enabling the use of thinner calf skin heads. The easier vibration of the thinner heads allows a triple snare to be used on the non-beaten head.

Hand made, with traditional goat skin heads tensioned by a system of hempen cord and sliding leather buffs. A single gut snare is fitted to the beaten head and a brass belt hook sets the correct playing position for the drum. Two drumsticks turned to historic pattern are supplied with each drum.

No previous experience of instrument making is required to build this Medieval drum kit. The instruction manual and photosheet take the builder 'step by step' through each stage of construction. A top quality kit is supplied ready to assemble around pre-bent haya hoops using a set of 40 special clamps. The diameter of the drum is fixed at 35cm but the builder determines the final depth of the drum up to 50cm and hence whether it is a side drum or long drum. Hemp cord, leather buffs, gut snares, a pair of traditional style drumsticks, all included in this versatile kit.

The mediaeval drum has rope tensioned goat skin heads with a single snare on the beaten head, whilst this renaissance drum has calf skin heads with rope tensioned counter hoops and a triple snare on the non-beaten head.

The shells of the drum kit are made from a laminated birch sheet and although the diameter is fixed at 14" (35cm), the kit builder determines the final depth, i. e. long drum 20" (50cm) or side drum 14" (35cm). The shell is assembled around pre-bent beech hoops. Included is a set of over forty clamps for this process. Hemp cord, leather buffs, gut snares and brass hardware complete a most versatile kit. No previous experience of instrument making is required and the instruction manual includes photographs on every stage of construction.

The triple gut snare operates on the non-beaten head and a fitted brass belt hook sets the correct playing position for the drum. Two drumsticks turned to an historic pattern are supplied with each drum.

Drum - Renaissance long drum kit

No previous experience of instrument making is required to build this Renaissance drum. An instruction manual and photosheet take the builder 'step by step' through each stage of construction. A top quality 3mm laminated abedul shell is supplied ready to assemble around pre-bent hickory hoops using a set of 40 special clamps. Two solid hickory counterhoops are supplied bent ready for final fitting. The diameter of the drum is fixed at 35cm but the builder determines the final depth of the drum up to 50cm and hence whether it is a side drum or a long drum. Hemp cord, leather buffs, gut snares, a pair of traditional style drumsticks.

The mediaeval drum has rope tensioned goat skin heads with a single snare on the beaten head, whilst this renaissance drum has calf skin heads with rope tensioned counter hoops and a triple snare on the non-beaten head.

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The word tabor can mean almost any size of drum but its most common usage describes a smaller diameter shallow drum. This style of drum is played slung over the wrist of the left hand which holds a 3-hole (tabor pipe) whilst the right hand has a single beater to provide the rhythmical accompaniment to the tune.

The shell is bent from solid steamed haya and after sanding and polishing is fitted with natural cloudy calf skin heads. The 12" tabor is tensioned using hemp cord. A single turned English sicomoro stick is supplied as standard.



The Tabor kit is easy to build and requires no previous experience of kit building. An instruction manual takes you step by step through the construction process and reveals how to tie the special knots and how to use the snare and its wedge adjustment. The main component, a solid haya shell, is supplied pre-bent ready for gluing, sanding and polishing. Cloudy calf skins, 2 haya hoops, 5 metres of hempen cord and a single stick in English sicomoro complete this straightforward kit.

Solid beech, steam-bent to the correct diameters, is supplied ready to form the shell and the hoops. Top quality cloudy calf skins are supplied for the heads. A single turned in English sycamore finishes the drum kit. Instructions on the use of the snare and its wedge adjustment and tying all relevant knots are included. Makes a high quality instrument.
